Walking Dogs - Dog Walkers are invited to visit the Shelter during viewing hours and speak with a Kennel Attendant to find a suitable dog for walking. Volunteers are asked to commit a minimum of 20 minutes for each dog walked. *Volunteers must be 13-years old or older to participate in the Dog Walking Program. Volunteers under age 13 must be accompanied by an adult.*

Bingo - The Shelter operates two bingo's each month as part of its fundraising program. Bingo's run in the evenings and require approximately 10 volunteers. Volunteers are asked to commit 4 hours for the event, beginning at 6 PM and finishing up around 10 PM. Bingo volunteers have numerous duties including selling bingo ticket sheets, making change and working with other team members. *Volunteers must be at least 18-years old and have their own transportation to participate at Bingos.*

Fundraising Events - The Shelter holds many special events throughout the year, see complete list on back of form. Fundraising Event Volunteers help with event set-up, ticket selling, poster distribution, penny parade and prize pick-ups. *Volunteers must be at least 18-years old, or be accompanied by an adult, to participate in Fundraising Events.*

Paws For Coffee Club - This group meets at the Shelter in the evening of the third Wednesday of each month to plan and organize fundraising and other events. Members participate in such areas as decorating the float for the parade, coordination of volunteers for events, helping distribute posters or participating on other committees, see complete list on back of form.

Pet Therapy - Volunteers take pets to visit those isolated in hospitals or nursing homes. Pet Therapy volunteers are required to have their own vehicle to transport pets to the extended care facility. Volunteer's must make an appointment to meet the Pet Therapy Coordinator to ensure their animal is suitable to work with the general public. *Volunteers must be at least 18-years old and have their own transportation to participate in the Pet Therapy Program.*

Volunteers under the age of 18 must have the approval of a parent or guardian. Volunteers under the age of 18 must carry with them immediate contact information for their parent or guardian should an emergency arise or volunteer work duties be completed.

We appreciate the help and time commitment of our volunteers.
We ask that volunteers limit their time at the Shelter to a maximum of 3 hours.

Moose Jaw Humane Society Committees for Volunteers

Bingo

Volunteers attend the twice-monthly bingo fundraisers, count forms, sell Nevadas and sell bingo sheets.

Event - Alley Cat Bowling

Volunteers attend the event, sell tickets, put up posters and work at the event.

Event - Bone-anza

Volunteers work some of the sales shifts at the Shelter's store-front at the Mall, sell tickets, answer questions and help pick-up prizes.

Event - Dog Days of Summer

Volunteers help find sponsors, distribute sponsor packages and put up posters.

Event - Dog Jog

Volunteers pick up supplies, attend the event, help prepare the BBQ (and other kitchen jobs), lead the walk through Wakamow, take registrations, put up posters, put up signs and help clean up after the event.

Event - Garage Sale

Volunteers help sort donated merchandise into the storage trailers, put up posters, help to unload the trailers a few days before the sale, unpack the items for sale and clean up after the sale is over. On the day of the sale volunteers help run various stations throughout the sale such as concession, antiques, furniture and jewelry.

Event - Lottery (June and Fall)

Volunteers help deliver lottery forms for stuffing and later for mailing.

Event - Pet Calendar

Volunteers help promote the fundraiser by selling spaces in the calendar. Volunteers also work at various sales stations (the Mall, Wal-Mart) to sell finished calendars (in December).

Event - Pet Patter

Volunteers help prepare the newsletter for mailing, deliver the newsletter and, on occasion, contribute stories.

Event - Santa Paws

Volunteers attend the event, set up for the event, pick up supplies, sell pet pictures with Santa, sell baking, usher guests to the photographer, pet-sit while owners mingle, sell pet calendars, and help with the clean up.

Event - Valentine's Day Beef Night

Volunteers attend the event, sell tickets, put up posters, buss tables, sell raffle tickets and make draws.

Paws For Coffee

Volunteers help set up chairs before the meeting, make coffee and clean up afterwards.

Pet Cemetery

Volunteers help weed the flowerbed, water the flowers and mow the lawn.

Pet Therapy

Volunteers visit seniors homes, school groups and community groups with a very friendly pet.

Posters

Volunteers help put up posters for various events at 200 pre-set locations around Moose Jaw.

SARCAN

Volunteers take the recyclables to SARCAN to allow Shelter staff to work on other tasks. Volunteers must have a valid drivers license and a truck.

Sewing

Volunteers help to sew pet bandanas and other items needed for resale at the Shelter. Volunteers must have their own sewing machine.

Yard Work

Volunteers help mow the lawn, rake leaves, water, provide general yard maintenance and basic upkeep of the exterior of the Shelter.
